30 hours Funding Information for September

If your child turns 3 before August 31st they will automatically be entitled to 15 hours of free government funding.

You may also be eligible for the 30 hours funding. Please visit <u>www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</u> to see the eligibility criteria and how to apply.

Once you complete the application you will receive an eligibility code if you have been successful.

Please provide us with your child's eligibility code by 17th August to ensure it will be activated for the Autumn Term.

We will soon be handing out letters informing you if your child is moving rooms in September and they will have plenty of opportunities to explore their new rooms with their current key person between now and September.
